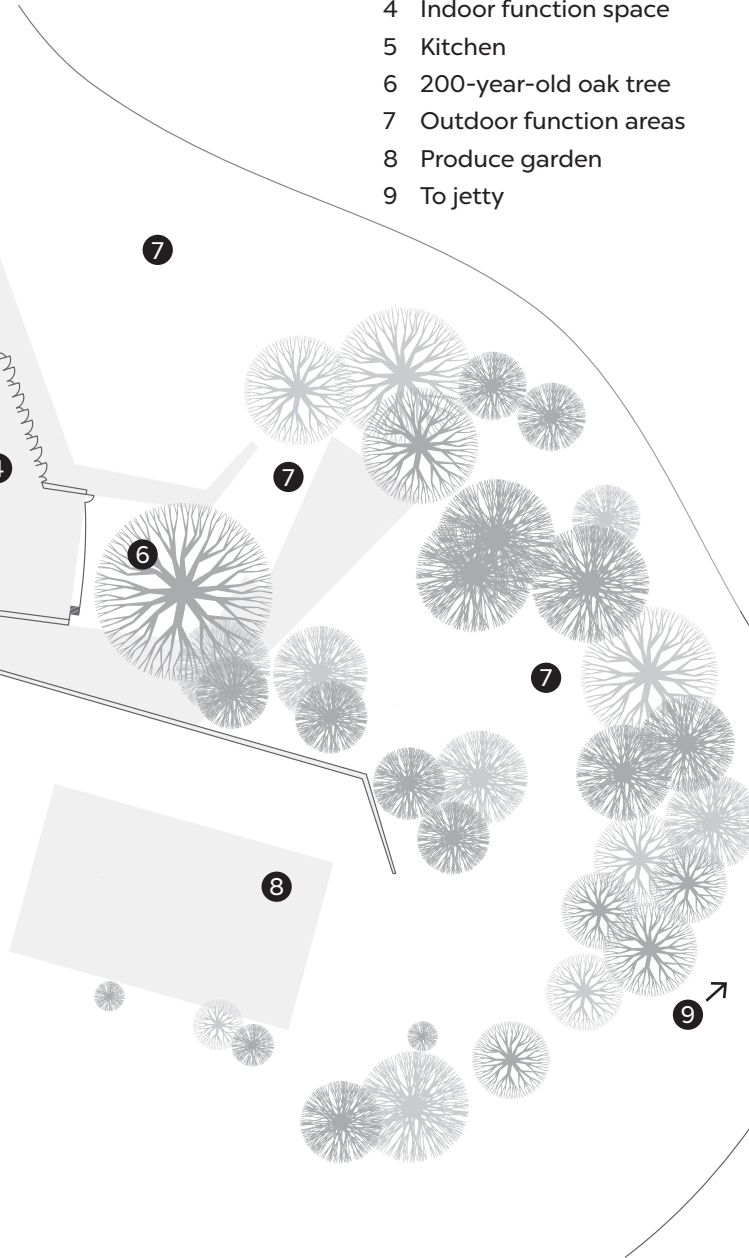
Set right on the waterfront, with views across to Bruny Island, Peppermint Bay's design was inspired by cliffs that line the coast of the D'Entrecasteaux Channel. These and other coastal landmarks are best viewed from our luxury 23m catamaran - Peppermint Bay II - which can transport up to 150 guests from Hobart in style. It can also be chartered as a separate function venue on its own.

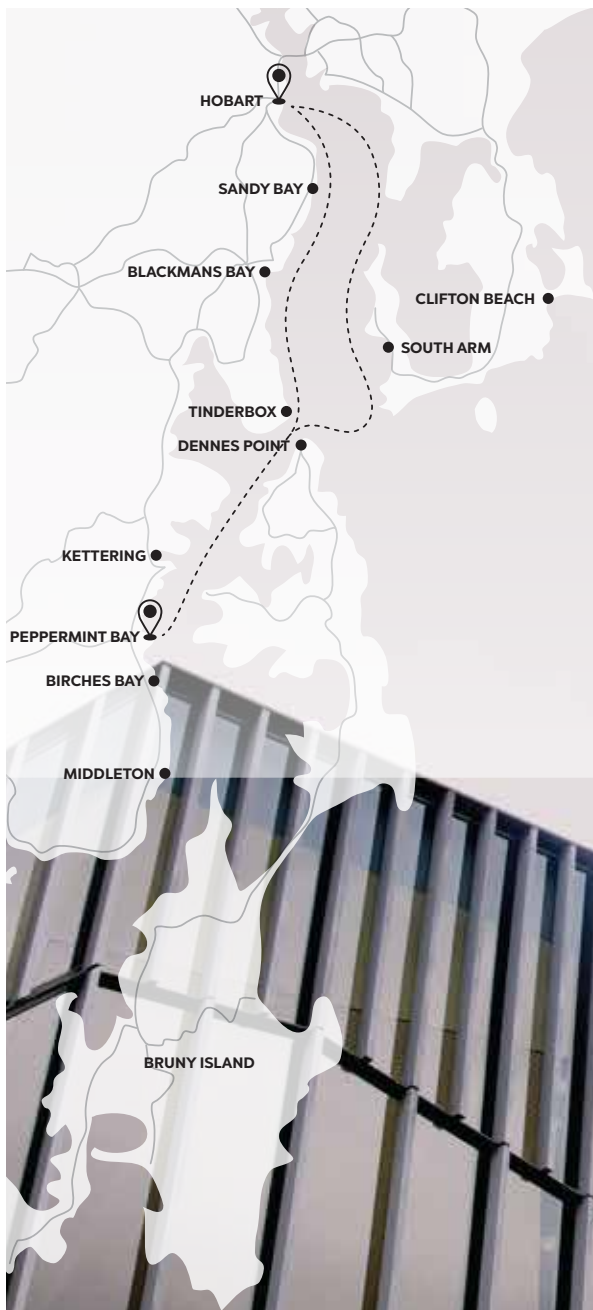
